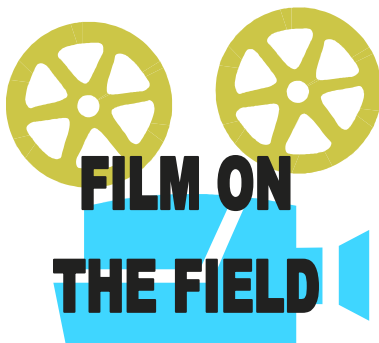
Thank you everyone for your patience and understanding during the renovation of the church sanctuary. The work is progressing as scheduled.

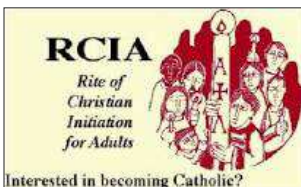
HOLY HOUR OF PRAYER will be held this Friday from 8:00 - 9:00 a.m. in the Daily Chapel.

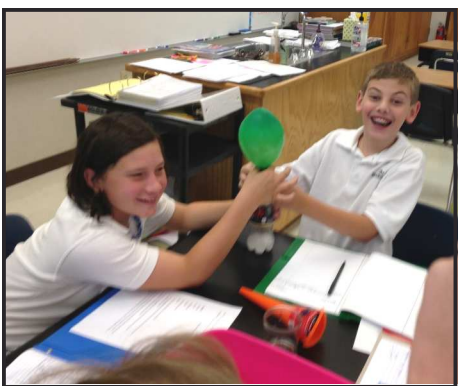

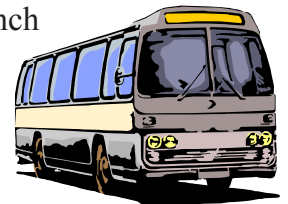

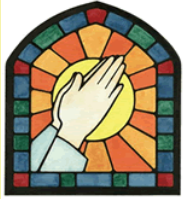
