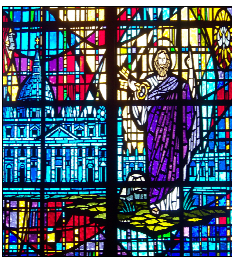
BABY BOTTLE CAMPAIGN

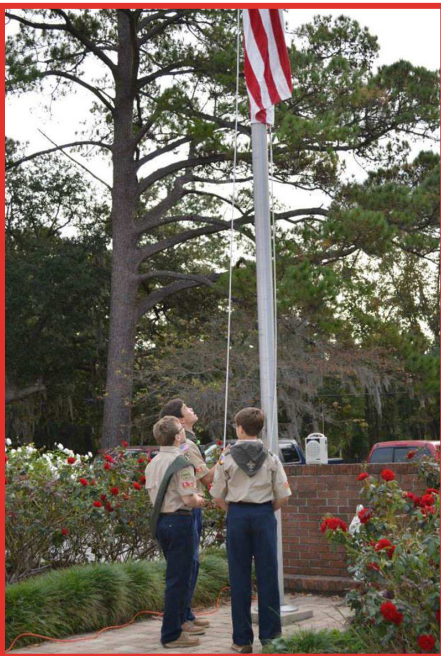
