
SAVE THE DATE





Our parish target is \$94,487 and we need everyone's participation to be able to meet that goal. There are extra pledge cards in the narthex if you need one. As of April 23rd our parish had reached 61% of the goal with \$57,684 being pledged from 19.38% of registered parishioners.



2015 CONFIRMATION CANDIDATES GUIDELINES

The Sacrament of Confirmation is regarded as the perfection of Baptism. This Sacrament confers special graces of the Holy

Spirit upon the person being confirmed, just as such graces were granted to the Apostles on Pentecost. Confirmation increases and deepens all of the graces granted at Baptism. What we at St. Peter the Apostle ask of our candidates: attendance of Religious Education classes (Diocesan guidelines require at least two years before a Sacrament), attendance of four sessions held on Sunday evenings (August 9, 16, 23 & 30, 2015), attend any retreats held for Confirmation, 25 hours of community service —works of mercy, and choosing a sponsor. The date for Confirmation here at St. Peter the Apostle Parish is November 12, 2015.
