
There will be a Second Collection this weekend at all Masses for the Catholic Campaign for Human Development. CCHD was founded to end the cycle of poverty in the United States by funding

GRACE Scholars is accepting pre-registration for 2016 tax credits and we need your help again!

Don't Delay - December 15, 2015 is the last date to pre-register!

Here's how pre-registration works: When you pre-register, you authorize GRACE Scholars to submit your tax credit application to the Georgia Department of Revenue (DOR) online portal. GRACE will input the applications on January 1, 2016—the first date that the DOR will accept 2016 applications.

What happens next? After you pre-register, you will receive an email from GRACE Scholars confirming the receipt of your information. After GRACE enters your tax credit application on January 1, the DOR will have 30 days to issue a letter of approval. You can make your contribution during a 60-day period starting the date of the approval letter. After the 60-day period expires, your tax credit will be void, and no extensions are possible.
