LIFETEEN/YOUTH MASS

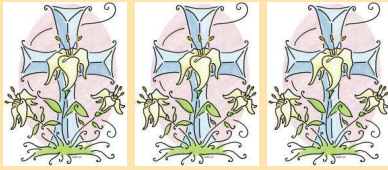

March 22nd - The Chrism Mass will be celebrated at the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist at 7:00 P.M. You are invited to join Bishop Hartmayer and the priests of the Diocese for this special liturgical celebration where the Blessing of the Oils and Consecration of the Chrism will occur and our priests will renew their commitment to priestly service.

March 24th - Holy Thursday Mass will be celebrated at 7:00 p.m. to commemorate Our Lord's Last Supper, followed by Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. The Altar of Adoration will be set up in the Daily Chapel and will remain open until 11:00 p.m.

March 25th - Good Friday There will be Stations of the Cross at 3:00 p.m. At 7:00 p.m. there will be a Liturgical Service and Veneration of the Cross and Holy Communion. The youth will perform the Living Stations following the service. The Pontifical Good Friday Collection is for the Holy Land.

March 26th - Holy Saturday Anticipated Mass of the Resurrection will be celebrated at 8:00 p.m. We will welcome our R.C.I.A. candidates into the Catholic faith at this Mass. Please note: there will be no 5:30 p.m. Vigil Mass on Holy Saturday.

March 27th - Easter Sunday Masses will be celebrated at 7:30 a.m., 9:00 a.m. (Children's Choir), 10:30 a.m. (Adult Choir), and 12 noon.

The Second Collection on Easter Sunday is for the Priests' Retirement Fund.

The Chaplet of Divine Mercy begins on Good Friday after the 3:00 p.m. Stations of the Cross and will continue on Easter Sunday at 3:00 p.m., Monday through Friday of Easter week at 6:00 p.m., Easter Saturday at 3:00 p.m. and Sunday, April 3rd, the Feast of Divine Mercy, at 3:00 p.m. Everyone is welcome.



Tenebrae, or “shadows” in Latin, is an expression of sorrow for the death of Christ. While the choir sings psalms and chants, lighted candles are gradually extinguished until only one candle remains. It's light, too, is also hidden and a loud noise is made symbolizing Christ's death, descent to the dead, and earthquake at the resurrection. The people leave in contemplative silence at the return of the Christ candle.
