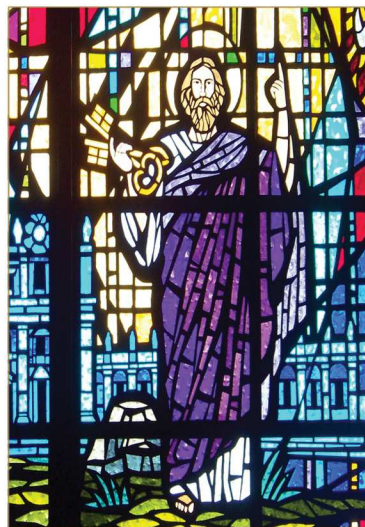

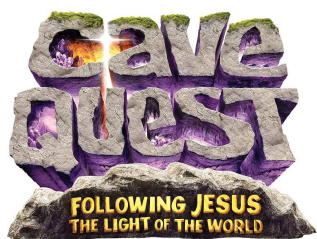
### FOREVER YOUNG NEWS

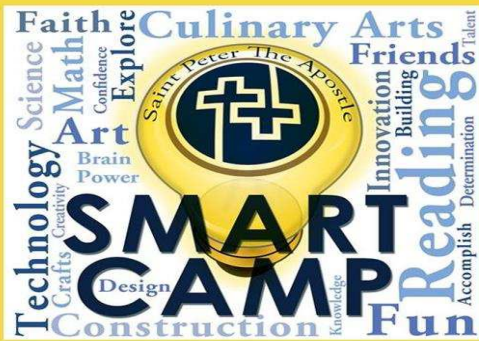
