

THIS Sunday, May 29th is the 5th Sunday of the month. The Knights of Columbus and their families meet immediately after the 9:00 a.m. Mass on



ARE YOU A "REGISTERED, ACTIVE

CATHOLIC"? A person must be registered in the parish, attend Mass on Sundays and Holy days of the year, participate in the sacraments, go to confession at least once a year, take part in the activities of the parish, and contribute to the offertory in a recognizable way (envelope or check) as a means of verification of attendance. Parish subsidy (Catholic tuition rate) for Catholic Schools will not be granted unless you are an "active, participating, registered Catholic." Any family who is registered in St. Peter the Apostle Parish who chooses to send their child to another Catholic school in Savannah will be charged an additional \$1,000 by that school.



Prayer and Action A Mission Experience in our own Backyard

High school teens - Have you always wanted to go on a Mission Trip but it was too expensive? Do you want to make a difference this Summer? Do you need high school service hours? Do you want to hang out for a week with your friends? Then register for Prayer and Action. This is an opportunity for a mission experience in your own backyard, reaching out to various communities in the Savannah area and providing for those most in


