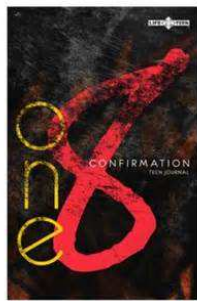
## Welcome Reception for Fr. Michael Kavanaugh

**2016 CONFIRMATION BOOT CAMP**

The Sacrament of Confirmation is regarded as the perfection of Baptism. Confirmation increases and deepens all of the graces granted at Baptism. At St. Peter the Apostle, we ask of our candidates: attendance of Religious Ed classes for at least two years, attendance at all four Boot Camp sessions, attend any retreats held for Confirmation, 25 hours of community service, and choosing a sponsor. Boot Camp dates are Sundays in August ( 7th, 14th, 21st, 28th) from 5:00 - 7:30 p.m. We found this to be a very impactful time with our Confirmation Candidates over the last couple of years. Our goal is to help you kick start your child’s faith life as a young adult. On August 7th, we will meet in the church for a Mass with the candidates and their families at 5:00 p.m. Parents are asked to stay in the church after Mass for a parent meeting. We invite all parishioners to come to the Mass on August 7th and support our Confirmation candidates. *The date of Confirmation here at St. Peter the Apostle Parish is November 30, 2016.*

***SAY YES TO GRACE***

GRACE Scholars is accepting pre-registration for 2017 tax credits and we need your help again! **Here's how pre-registration works** When you pre-register, you authorize GRACE Scholars to submit your tax credit application to the Georgia Department of Revenue (DOR) online portal. GRACE will input the applications on January 1, 2017—the first date that the DOR will accept 2017 applications.

**What happens next?** After you pre-register, you will receive an email from GRACE Scholars confirming the receipt of your information. After GRACE enters your tax credit application on January 1, the DOR will have 30 days to issue a letter of approval. You can make your contribution during a 60-day period starting the date of the approval letter. After the 60-day period expires, your tax credit will be void, and no extensions are possible.

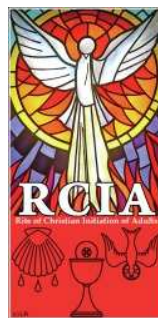

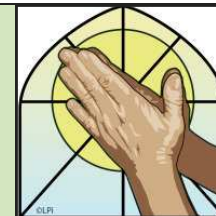
