These rites, therefore, should complete the conversion of the elect and deepen their resolve to hold fast to Christ and to carry out their decision to love God above all. The first scrutiny will be Saturday, March 18th at the 5:30 p.m. Mass. Please pray for the elect as they prepare to enter the church on Holy Saturday.



COMING IN MAY

Each year our parish provides substantial support of the school in the form of direct subsidy and tuition assistance to some families. ARE YOU AN ACTIVE PARTICIPATING PARISHIONER?

In order to receive the Catholic rate of tuition in Catholic schools in our

diocese, a family must be registered in the parish, attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of the year, participate in the Sacraments, go to confession at least once a year and take part in the activities of the parish. You must contribute to the offertory in a recognizable way (envelope or check) as a means of verification of your attendance.



Beginning in the 2015/16 school year, there was a 3-tiered tuition schedule approved for Catholic schools as outlined by the Savannah


Deanery. The purpose of this change was to relieve the parishes of the financial burden of subsidizing other Catholic schools and put it on the parents who choose not to have their children attend their parish school. In summary, if a family chooses to put their child in another Catholic school other than their parish school, they will pay the out of parish tuition rate, which is an additional \$1,000 per child added on to their tuition. If our parish office signs a participating parishioner card for another elementary school, it only means that we are verifying your attendance and participation at St. Peter the Apostle, NOT that we are paying the \$1,000 out of parish charge.
