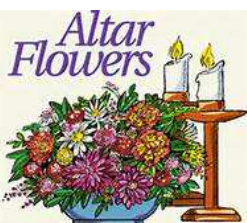

LENTEN SERVICES On the Fridays of Lent, we have Stations of the Cross at 6:30 p.m.

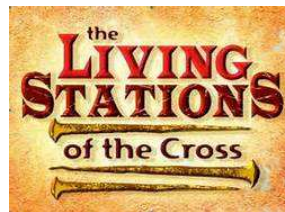

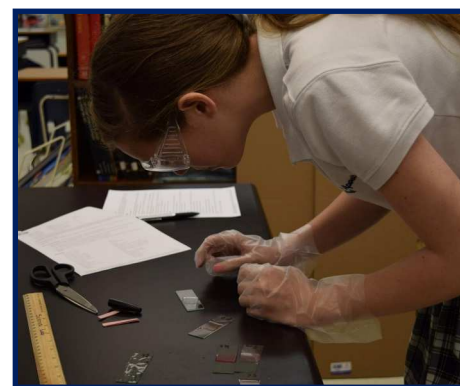
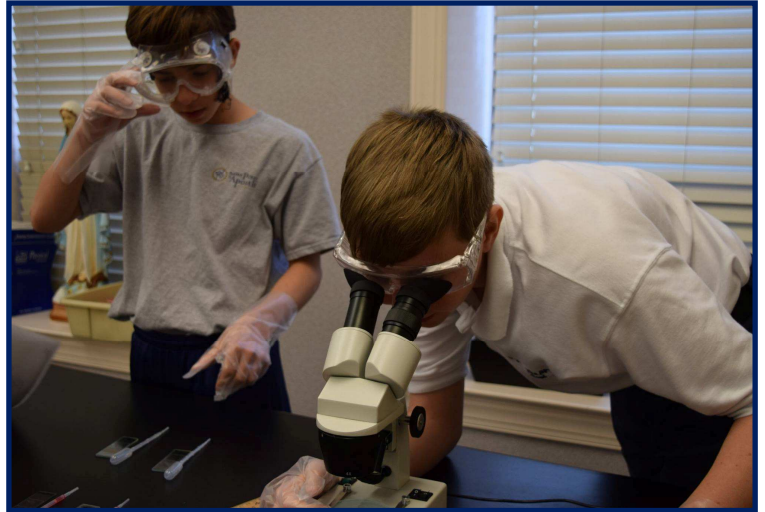
