April 13th - Holy Thursday Mass will be celebrated at 7:00 p.m. to commemorate Our Lord's Last Supper, followed by Exposition of the Blessed sacrament. The Altar of Adoration will be set up in the Daily Chapel and will remain open until 11:00 p.m. NOTE: THERE IS NO MORNING MASS ON HOLY THURSDAY. *April 14th - Good Friday* There will be Stations of the Cross at 3:00 p.m. At 7:00 p.m. there will be a Liturgical Service and Veneration of the Cross and Holy Communion. April 15th - Holy Saturday Anticipated Mass of the Resurrection will be celebrated at 8:30 p.m. We will welcome our R.C.I.A. candidates into the Catholic faith at this Mass. Please note: there will be NO 5:30 p.m. Vigil Mass on Holy Saturday.

April 16th - Easter Sunday Masses will be celebrated at 7:00 a.m., 8:30 a.m., 10:30 a.m. and 12:15 p.m. The Second Collection is for the Priest's Retirement Fund.

The Chaplet of Divine Mercy begins on Easter Sunday at 3:00 p.m., then continues Monday through Friday of Easter week at 6:00 p.m., Easter Saturday at 3:00 p.m. and Sunday, April 23rd, the Feast of Divine Mercy, at 3:00 p.m. Everyone is welcome.
