**PLEASE SAY YES TO GRACE** GRACE Scholars is accepting pre-registration for 2018 tax credits and we need your help again!

Here's how pre-registration works When you preregister, you authorize GRACE Scholars to submit your tax credit application to the Georgia Department of Revenue (DOR) online portal. GRACE will input the applications on January 1, 2018—the first date that the DOR will accept 2018 applications.

What happens next? After you pre-register, you will receive an email from GRACE Scholars confirming the receipt of your information. After GRACE enters your tax credit application on January 1, the DOR will have 30 days to issue a letter of approval. You can make your contribution during a 60-day period starting the date of the approval letter. After the 60-day period expires, your tax credit will be void, and no extensions are possible.




evangelization, and education of clergy and lay ministers. Please respond generously to this appeal.





#### 2017 CONFIRMATION CANDIDATE EXPECTATIONS



Attendance at Mass is the most important step if someone is preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation and adhering to the precepts of the

Church.

Choose a qualified sponsor - The sponsor must be baptized and confirmed and a practicing Catholic in good standing and must be at least 17 years old. Parents are not allowed to serve as a sponsor but a sibling may. If the child's godparent is still active in his or her life, they are a good choice. If the sponsor is unavailable on the day of Confirmation or practice, a proxy may stand in. Community Service - 25 hours with a nonprofit. Vacation Bible School (July 10-14) and Family Promise (July 17 - July 30) are two great chances over the summer here at SPA. **Confirmation Boot Camp** and any retreats or rehearsals held (dates TBA as soon as the Diocese issues the date for Confirmation). Boot Camp dates are Sundays in August (13th, 20th, 27th) and September 3rd from 5:00 - 7:00 p.m. We found this to be a very impactful time with our Confirmation Candidates over the last couple of years. Our goal is to help you kick start your child's faith life as a young adult. Date of Confirmation is TBA by the Bishop.
