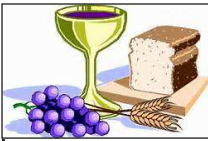

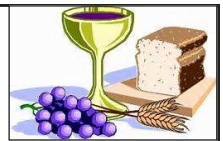

PLEASE SAY 'YES' TO GRACE



GRACE Scholars is accepting pre-registration for 2018 tax credits and we need your help again!

Here's how pre-registration works When you pre-register, you authorize GRACE Scholars to submit your tax credit application to the Georgia Department of Revenue (DOR) online portal. GRACE will input the applications on January 1, 2018—the first date that the DOR will accept 2018 applications.

What happens next? After you pre-register, you will receive an email from GRACE Scholars confirming the receipt of your information. After GRACE enters your tax credit application on January 1, the DOR will have 30 days to issue a letter of approval. You can make your contribution during a 60-day period starting the date of the approval letter. After the 60-day period expires, your tax credit will be void, and no extensions are possible.

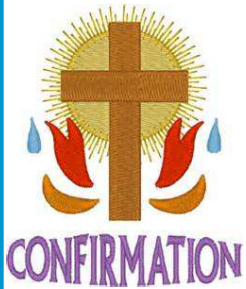
SECOND COLLECTION

2017 CONFIRMATION BOOT CAMP

The Sacrament of Confirmation is regarded as the perfection of Baptism. Confirmation increases and deepens all of the graces granted at Baptism. At St. Peter the Apostle, we ask of our candidates: attendance of Religious Ed classes for at least two years, attendance at all four Boot Camp sessions, attend any retreats held for Confirmation (dates TBA), 25 hours of community service, and choosing a sponsor. Boot Camp dates are Sundays, August 13th, 20th, 27th & September 3rd from 5:00 - 7:30 p.m. We found this to be a very impactful time with our Confirmation Candidates over the last couple of years. Our goal is to help you kick start your child's faith life as a young adult.

On August 13th, parents are asked to drop their student off at the parish center at 5:00 p.m. and then go to the church for a brief parent meeting with Fr. Kavanaugh. We invite all parishioners and friends to come to the LifeTeen Mass on August 20th at 5:00 p.m. to support our Confirmation candidates on their Faith Journey.

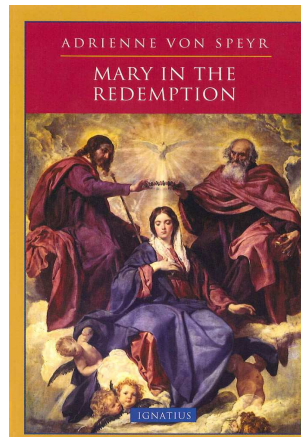
