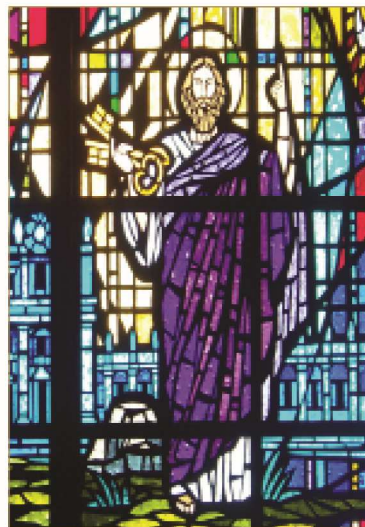

If you have not yet had an opportunity to register in the parish, please take a Census Form from the narthex of the church or go to the parish website for instructions.



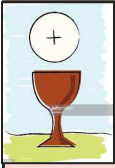

**ARE YOU AN ACTIVE CATHOLIC/  
PARTICIPATING PARISHIONER?**

A person must be registered in the parish, attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days, participate in the Sacraments, go to confession at least once a year and take part in the activities of the parish. You must contribute to the offertory in a recognizable way (envelope or check) as a means of verification of attendance. We cannot sign a Participating Parishioner card for another Catholic school or you will also not be eligible to receive the parish subsidy (Catholic rate tuition) for St. Peter the Apostle School unless the above requirements are met. This is the policy for the entire Diocese of Savannah.
