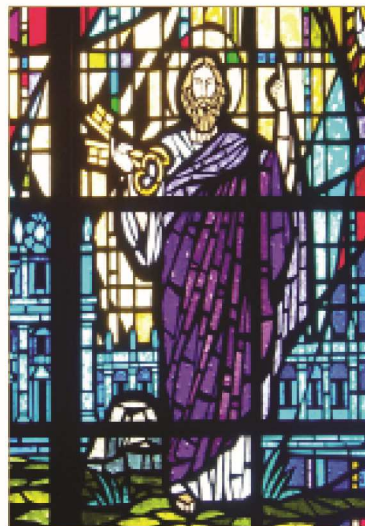

JUST A REMINDER TO ALL CATHOLIC FAMILIES WHO ARE REQUESTING THE "CATHOLIC TUITION RATE"

A person must be registered in the parish (or another parish in the diocese), attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of the year, participate in the Sacraments, go to confession at least once a year and take part in the activities of the parish. You must contribute to the offertory in a recognizable way (envelope or check) as a means of verification of attendance. It is your responsibility as parents to keep the promises you made at your child's baptism to train them in the teachings of the Catholic Church. Please make sure you are attending Mass with your children each weekend.

Since St. Peter the Apostle Parish subsidizes St. Peter the Apostle School, any Catholic family who does not meet the above requirements will not be eligible to receive the parish subsidy for the Catholic rate of tuition. 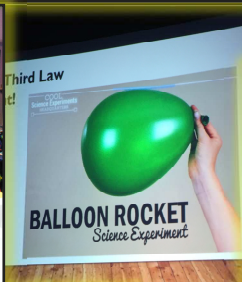

2018 CONFIRMATION CANDIDATE EXPECTATIONS



Attendance at Mass is the most important step if someone is preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation and adhering to the precepts of the Church.

Choose a qualified sponsor - The sponsor must be baptized and confirmed and a practicing Catholic in good standing and must be at least 17 years old. Parents are not allowed to serve as a sponsor but a sibling may. If the child's godparent is still active in his or her life, they are a good choice. If the sponsor is unavailable on the day of Confirmation or practice, a proxy may stand in.

Community Service - 25 hours with a non-profit. Vacation Bible School (July 9-13) and Family Promise (July 15 - July 29) are two great chances over the summer here at SPA.

Confirmation Boot Camp and any retreats or rehearsals held. Boot Camp dates are Sundays in August (5th, 12th, 19th & 26th) from 5:00 - 7:00 p.m. We found this to be a very impactful time with our Confirmation Candidates over the last few years. Our goal is to help you kick start your child's faith life as a young adult.

Date of Confirmation is November 27, 2018.

STUDY SKILLS COURSE for college-bound middle and high school students will be held at St. Vincent's July 31st - August 3rd from 1:00 - 3:30 p.m. Cost is \$85 per student. Students will learn time management and organization, how to take notes and study for a test, learning styles and processing of information, and resources to help students stay motivated. PLEASE SAY YES TO GRACE
GRACE Scholars is accepting pre-registration for 2019 tax credits and we need your help again!

Here's how pre-registration works When you pre-register, you authorize GRACE Scholars to submit your tax credit application to the Georgia Department of Revenue (DOR) online portal. GRACE will input the applications on January 1, 2019—the first date that the DOR will accept 2019 applications.

What happens next? After you pre-register, you will receive an email from GRACE Scholars confirming the receipt of your information. After GRACE enters your tax credit application on January 1, the DOR will have 30 days to issue a letter of approval. You can make your contribution during a 60-day period starting the date of the approval letter. After the 60-day period expires, your tax credit will be void, and no extensions are possible.
