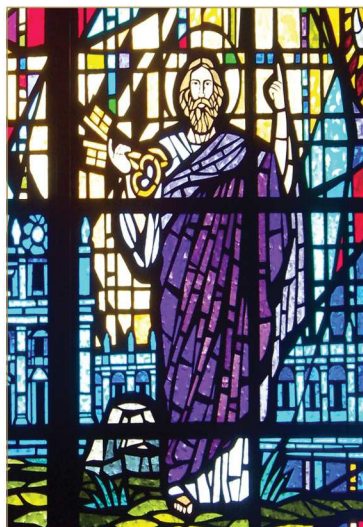

THE FEAST OF THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

of Obligation. Masses will be at 7:30 a.m., 8:30 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Please make every effort to attend Mass that day.



The four pillars of hospitality, prayer, formation and service invite parishioners to experience, witness and live the stewardship way of life in response to their baptismal call to discipleship. Individually, each baptized person is called to give of time, talent and treasure to strengthen these four pillars that support the parish community.



VIRTUS CLASSES This training is required for Safe Environment Compliance for any adult who will come into

contact with youth as part of their ministry and must be completed before they begin their ministry. Those who serve in the following ministries should have Virtus training: Ushers, Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, Youth Choir, K of C, Men's Club, CCW, Nursery, Family Promise, Teachers (both school and CCD), and all school volunteers. 2018 CONFIRMATION BOOTCAMP

The Sacrament of Confirmation is regarded as the perfection of Baptism. Confirmation increases and deepens all of the graces granted at Baptism. At St. Peter the Apostle, we ask of our candidates: attendance of Religious Ed classes for at least two years, attendance at all four Boot Camp sessions, attend any retreats held for Confirmation (dates TBA), 25 hours of community service, and choosing a sponsor. Boot Camp dates are Sundays- August 5th, 12th, 19th & 26th from 5:00 - 7:30 p.m. We found this to be a very impactful time with our Confirmation Candidates over the last couple of years. Our goal is to help you kick start your child's faith life as a young adult. We invite all parishioners and friends to come to the LifeTeen Mass on August 19th at 5:00 p.m. to support our Confirmation candidates on their Faith Journey.

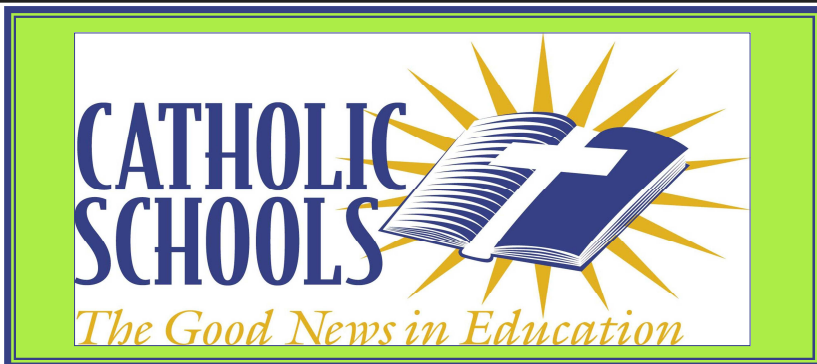

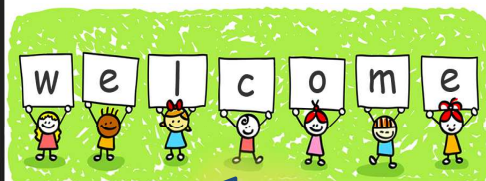

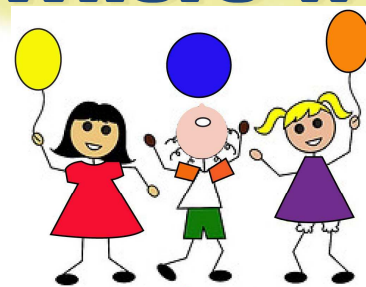
