

Confirmation The Sacrament of Confirmation is regarded as the perfection of Baptism. Confirmation increases and deepens all of the graces granted at Baptism. At St. Peter the Apostle, we ask of our candidates: attendance of Religious Ed classes for at least two years, attendance at all four Boot Camp sessions, attend any retreats held for Confirmation (dates TBA), 25 hours of community service, and choosing a sponsor. 
