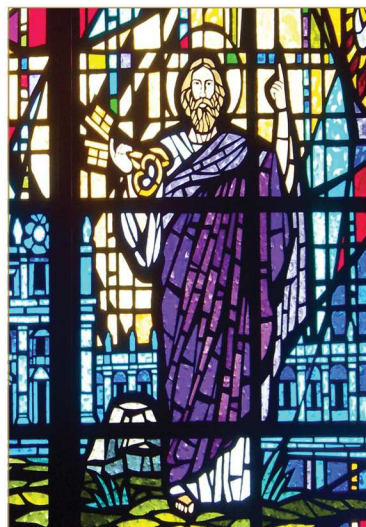

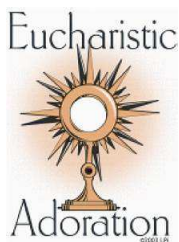

Religious Education

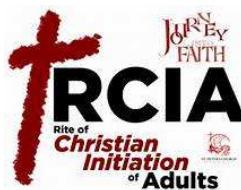
CCD(CONFRATERNITY OF CHRISTIAN DOCTRINE) Any student in grades K-8 who does not

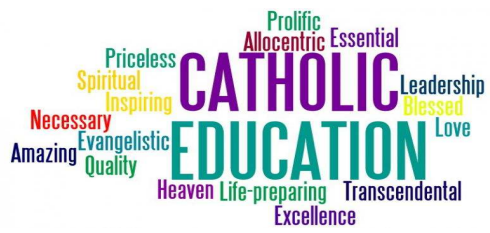
