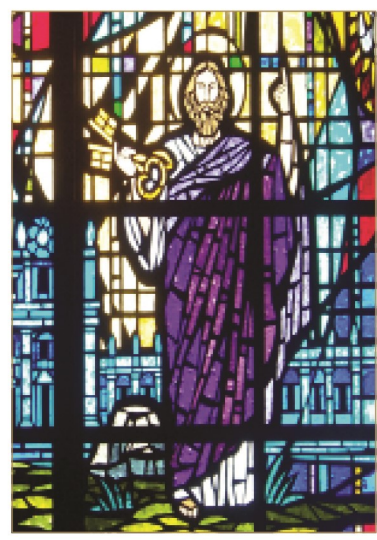

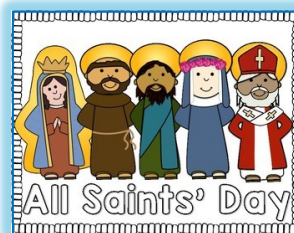

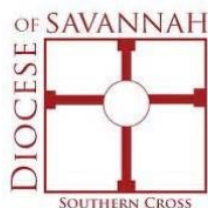
There is a notebook in the narthex for you to write the names of loved ones who have passed away **in the last year (November 1, 2017 until present)**. These

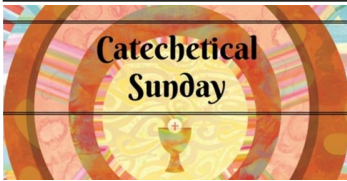

CATECHETICAL SUNDAY Next Sunday, October 28th at the 9:00 a.m. Mass, those whom the community has

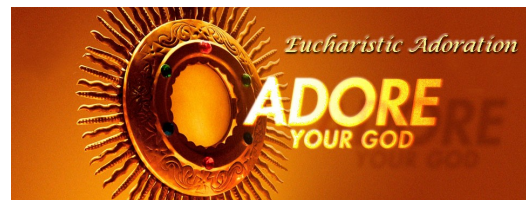

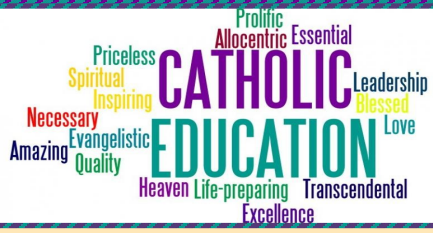

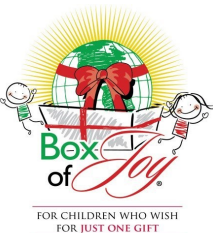


GRACE SCHOLARS STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM
USE YOUR TAX DOLLARS TO SUPPORT CATHOLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS

Thank you for your past contributions and continued support assuring the success of Catholic schools and their students through the **GRACE Scholars Student Scholarship Program**. Your involvement allows Catholic schools to transform lives by providing financial aid to students in need. Although applications cannot be submitted to the Department of Revenue until January 2, 2019, GRACE allows donors the opportunity to reserve their spot for 2019 **NOW**. GRACE will submit requests for tax credits on behalf of donors the first business day of January. The statewide cap is likely to be met that day as it has in the past few year.

REGISTER TO BE A GRACE DONOR TODAY! The statewide cap for education expense credits increases to \$100 million per year beginning in 2019. Due to this increase, it is estimated that approved tax credits will be prorated at approximately 90% which is a remarkable increase from 55% in 2018. Individuals with ownership in S-Corps, LLCs or Partnerships (pass-through entities) may contribute up to \$10,000 to GRACE, so long as they would have paid Georgia income tax in that amount on their share of taxable income.

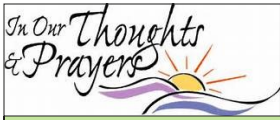
