

Think about what the best time would be for you to meet in a group—you may sign-up after Mass this weekend. The program begins the first week of Lent, which starts on March 6th.




APPLY NOW FOR GRACE SCHOLARS

REMINDER TO ALL CATHOLIC ST. PETER THE APOSTLE SCHOOL FAMILIES

In order to receive the "Catholic" rate of tuition a family must be active, participating parishioners, which is defined as follows: A person must be registered in the parish, attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of the year, participate in the Sacraments, go to confession at least once a year and take part in the activities of the parish. You must contribute to the offertory in a recognizable way, (envelope or check), as a means of verification of attendance. Since St. Peter the Apostle Parish subsidizes St. Peter the Apostle School, any Catholic family who does not meet the above requirements will not be eligible to receive the parish subsidy for the Catholic rate of tuition. This is a requirement of the Catholic Diocese of Savannah.
