

At St. Peter the Apostle, we ask of our candidates: attendance of Religious Ed classes for at least two years, attendance at all four Boot Camp sessions, attend any retreats held for Confirmation, 25 hours of community service, and choosing a sponsor. Boot Camp dates are Sundays-September 15th, 22nd, 29th and October 6th from 5:00 - 7:30 p.m. *Attendance at all four Boot Camp dates is mandatory*. We found this to be a very impactful time with our Confirmation Candidates over the last several years. Our goal is to help you kick start your child's faith life as a young adult. 
