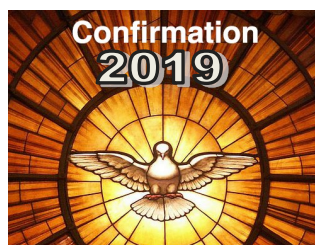

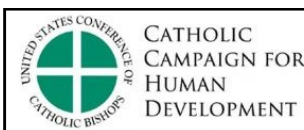

SECOND COLLECTION

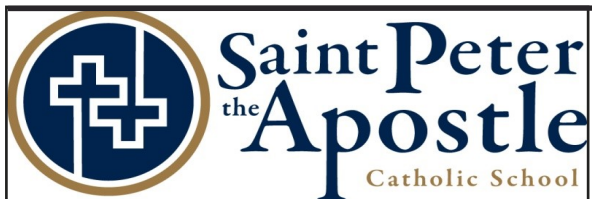
Next weekend at all Masses there will be a second collection for the
