

<u>ASH WEDNESDAY</u> The beginning of the Holy Season of Lent is **Wednesday**, **February 26th**. This is one of the two days of the year when Catholics are obligated to observe the laws of fast and abstinence. The Mass times are 7:30 a.m., 8:30 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. Please make every effort to attend with your family. <u>SPECIAL COLLECTION</u> The collection on Ash Wednesday is for Aid to Eastern Europe. Please respond generously.

LENTEN SERVICES On the Fridays of Lent, we will have Stations of the Cross at 6:30 p.m.

LENTEN REGULATIONS Catholics who are over the age of 18 and under the age of 60 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, which means that they can eat only one complete meal and two smaller meals during the day, with no food in between. Catholics who are over the age of 14 are required to refrain from eating any meat, or any food made with meat, on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays during Lent.

### KID'S CORNER WAYS TO ENGAGE YOUR CHILDREN IN MASS

When our children see us looking forward to and engaging in Mass, it sets an example for them to follow. Our attitude towards the Mass and participation in it will stick with them in a very powerful way.

- **@Unpack the Mass**: After the Mass is over, discuss the Scriptures with them on the way home, along with elements of the liturgy that seemed striking.
- **Sit up front**: Sit as close to the front as possible, where children can observe the action of the Mass. This introduces children to the rhythm of the liturgy.
- **@Give them something appropriate to look at:** There are several Children's Mass books available in the narthex for your children to look at during Mass. We ask you to please return them before you leave so others may enjoy them.
- **Encourage children to serve in appropriate liturgical ministries:** If your children are old enough, encourage them to become altar servers, to participate in the children's choir, or to bring the gifts forward. Directly participating in these ministries will give them a different perspective on the Mass and a sense of ownership.


