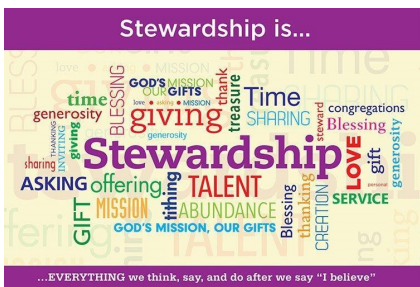

The first Wednesday of each month is Family Night. 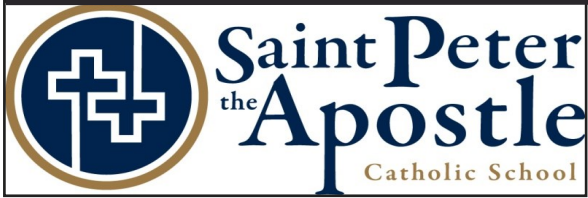
Wednesday nights: Grades 2,3,7 & 8 will meet from 6:30-7:30 p.m. in the Youth Center.

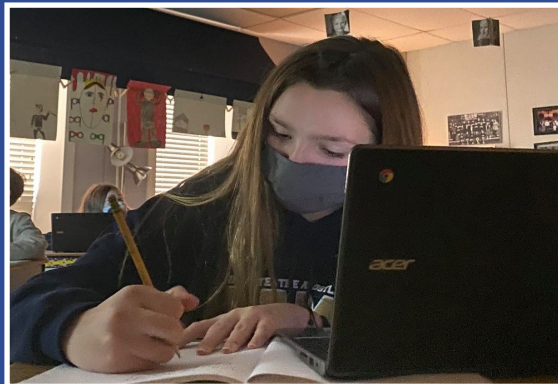

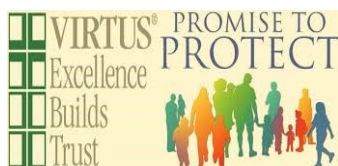
