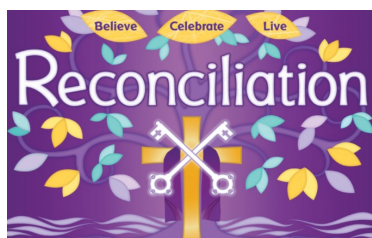

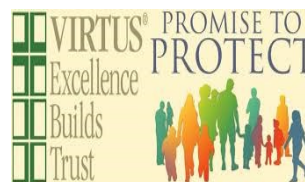

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: CCD The first Wednesday of each month is Family Night. TO ALL CATHOLIC FAMILIES REQUESTING OR RECEIVING CATHOLIC TUITION RATE AT

ST. PETER THE APOSTLE SCHOOL

To receive the participating Catholic tuition rate, a family must be:

- *Registered in the Parish
- *Attend Mass on all Sundays and Holy Days
- *Participate in the Sacraments of the Church
- *Go to confession at least once a year
- *Participate actively in parish events
- *Contribute regularly to the parish offertory in a recognizable way, by parish envelope or check

The same requirements hold for a family requesting verification for the Catholic tuition rate at Benedictine Military School and/or St. Vincent's Academy.

If your family is newly registered in our parish, you can qualify for the Catholic tuition rate by having the pastor of your former parish verify that you were an active, participating member of that parish.

If you have been a non-participating family but are returning to Mass and to regular participation, you can qualify for the Catholic tuition rate after six months of meeting the requirements listed above.

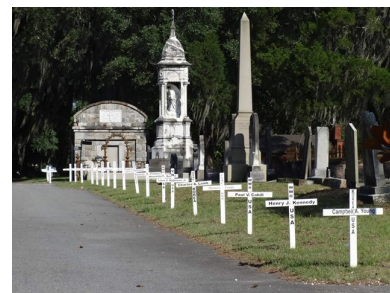

MEMORIAL CROSSES The Catholic War Veterans of Savannah will again be placing Memorial Crosses in the Catholic Cemetery (1720 Wheaton St.). The crosses will be put in place on May 26th and remain in place through Memorial Day. A Memorial Mass will be celebrated at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 27th at the cemetery. If you would like to honor a deceased veteran in this manner, contact Bart Picasso at bart.picasso@comcast.net or 856-3512 no later than April 26th. Interment at the Catholic Cemetery is not required. There is a one-time fee of \$30 for initial supplies. The crosses will continue to be maintained and placed in the cemetery each year thereafter.

COMPUTER TECHNICIAN NEEDED The Diocese of Savannah has an opening for a full-time Information Technology Tech. This position reports to the Director of Information Technology and is responsible for providing support for local and remote workers in Savannah. Specifically, this position supports mobile devices used by staffers at the Catholic Pastoral Center, works with VMWare, Windows Server 2019, Microsoft Office 365 as well as Mitel Voice/Phone systems. This position will be trained as a back-up for the director, able to assume additional responsibilities as skill and training is developed. Candidates should have a minimum of two years of advanced education, a BS in Information Technology is preferred, and 3 years' experience. A Catholic in good standing is preferred, but not required.
