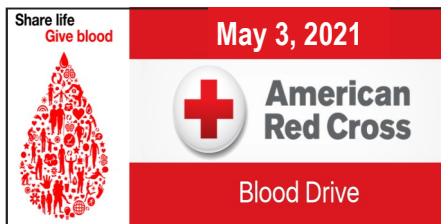

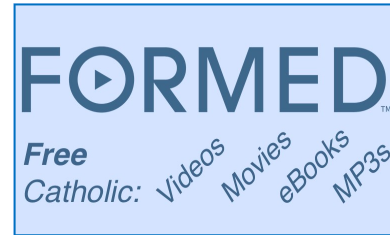

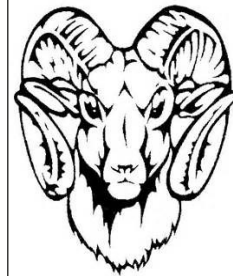

*To receive the participating Catholic tuition rate, a family must be:*

- \*Registered in the Parish
  - \*Attend Mass on all Sundays and Holy Days
  - \*Participate in the Sacraments of the Church
  - \*Go to confession at least once a year
  - \*Participate actively in parish events
  - \*Contribute regularly to the parish offertory in a recognizable way, by parish envelope or check
- The same requirements hold for a family requesting verification for the Catholic tuition rate at Benedictine Military School and/or St. Vincent's Academy.

If your family is newly registered in our parish, you can qualify for the Catholic tuition rate by having the pastor of your former parish verify that you were an active, participating member of that parish.

If you have been a non-participating family but are returning to Mass and to regular participation, you can qualify for the Catholic tuition rate after six months of meeting the requirements listed above.

The crosses will be put in place on May 26th and remain in place through Memorial Day. A Memorial Mass will be celebrated at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 27th at the cemetery.
