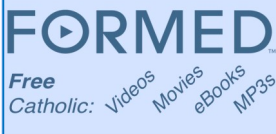

### **What does the Catholic Church says in regards to the Covid-19 vaccines?**

The chairs of the Committees on Doctrine and Pro-Life Activities of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops have declared that the Pfizer and Moderna vaccines are morally permissible and can be used in good conscience.
