



are so grateful for his spiritual leadership and friendship and are blessed to have him in our parish. May God continue to bless him each and every day!






















Everyone is invited to join us for the Youth Mass on June 20th at 5:00 p.m. The liturgy and music are geared towards the youth and



Catholic Tuition Rate Per Fr. Kavanaugh Catholic schools, including Saint Peter the Apostle, St. Vincent's Academy, and Benedictine Military School, offer a lower tuition rate for Catholic families who are active, participating members of a parish. To qualify for this rate, a Catholic family MUST be attending mass regularly. Also, that family MUST be making regular recognizable offertory contributions to the parish. "Regular" means every Sunday. "Recognizable" means by check, by offertory envelope, by Bill Pay through your bank, or through online giving. Loose cash dropped in the collection basket is NOT a recognizable contribution. Families who use electronic contributions are required to put an envelope in the offertory marked "online giving" when they attend mass. Please, do not ask for a Participating Catholic Card for Benedictine or St. Vincent's if you are not a participating Catholic as described above. If you are unable to contribute even a small amount regularly in a recognizable form, please call Fr. Kavanaugh and we will see what can be done.



## What does the Catholic Church says in regards to the Covid-19 vaccines?

The chairs of the Committees on Doctrine and Pro-Life Activities of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops have declared that the Pfizer and Moderna vaccines are morally permissible and can be used in good conscience. But if these are not available, it is morally acceptable to receive COVID-19 vaccines that come from compromised cell lines like Johnson & Johnson's vaccine.

The Bishops have concluded that "being vaccinated safely against COVID-19 should be considered an act of love of our neighbor and part of our moral responsibility for the common good."
