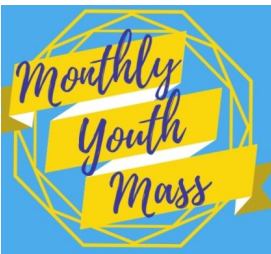

youth and the young at heart. At this Mass, we will be honoring all Dads and all 2021 graduates.

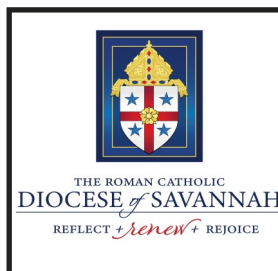
