



Catholic schools, including Saint Peter the Apostle, St. Vincent's Academy, and Benedictine Military School, offer a lower tuition rate for Catholic families who are active, participating members of a parish. To qualify for this rate, a Catholic family MUST be attending mass regularly. Also, that family MUST be making regular recognizable offertory contributions to the parish. "Regular" means every Sunday. "Recognizable" means by check, by offertory envelope, by Bill Pay through your bank, or through online giving. Loose cash dropped in the collection basket is NOT a recognizable contribution. Families who use electronic contributions are required to put an envelope in the offertory marked "online giving" when they attend mass. Please, do not ask for a Participating Catholic Card for Benedictine or St. Vincent's if you are not a participating Catholic as described above. If you are unable to contribute even a small amount regularly in a recognizable form, please call Fr. Kavanaugh and we will see what can be done.
