



Saturday, August 21, 2021 Crabbers may fish anytime during the day. Weigh-in from 5:00 – 6:00 PM at Savannah Boathouse. All Crabbers must be in line by 6:00 PM. CRABBING DAY:

Saturday, August 21, 2021 from 6:00 - 8:00 PM at Savannah Boathouse. Crab Boil and Live Music to follow BACK TO SCHOOL BASH:

\$100 per team, includes four (4) entries; additional crabbers \$25 per person ENTRY FEE:

Each Crabber will receive one (1) tournament t-shirt and one (1) tournament koozie.

EXTRA T-SHIRTS: Additional T-Shirts can be purchased and must be listed below. Adult \$20/Child \$15. You do not have to

participate to purchase a t-shirt. T-shirts must be purchased by August 7, 2021 to guarantee availability.

FISHING AREAS: Boats may crab any waters located in the surrounding area or off any dock (private or public).

PRIZES & AWARDS:

OVERALL WINNER: The winner will be determined by the aggregate weight of twelve (12) crabs.

Two (2) Special Awards will be awarded based on the following criteria:

The largest blue crab from point to point SPECIAL AWARDS:

The "rustiest" crab

RULES:

All Georgia DNR recreational blue crabbing guidelines apply. Teams may crab from either boat or dock. Hand lines and/or baskets only – NO CRAB TRAPS Only male crabs will be weighed. Female crabs have "red lipstick" on the tips of their claws. Crabs must be at least 5-inches from spike to spike. You may NOT cull your catch at the scales. Weigh-in will be from 5:00 – 6:00 PM.

WEATHER: Team Captain accepts full responsibility for the safety and conduct of his/her crew. The decision to crab is up to the Captain.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Registration deadline: August 18, 2021, however t-shirt sizes will not be guaranteed after August 7, 2021.

All Captains must sign in with the Weighmaster in order to be eligible for awards.

Important: Indicate T-Shirt for each crabber. Sizes Available: Adult S, M, L, XL, XXL; and Child S, M, or L.
