**PARISH COUNCIL MEETING** will be held on Tuesday, March 22nd at 6:30 p.m. in the parish center room #1. All members are asked to attend.

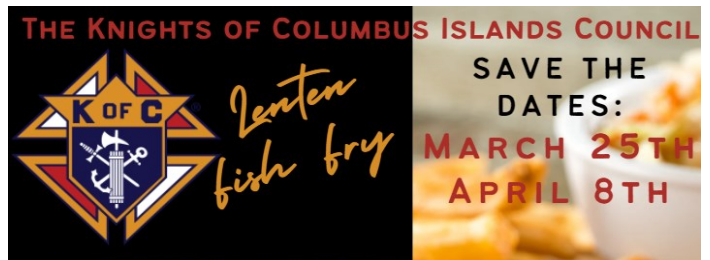

**LENTEN REGULATIONS** Catholics who are over the age of 18 and under the age of 60 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, which means that they can eat only one complete meal and two smaller meals during the day, with no food in between. Catholics who are over the age of 14 are required to refrain from eating meat, or any food made with meat, on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays during Lent.
