

LENTEN SERVICES On the Fridays of Lent, we will have Stations of the Cross at 6:30 p.m., ALSO at 2:15 p.m. on April 1st & 8th. **LENTEN REGULATIONS** Catholics who are over the age of 18 and under the age of 60 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, which means that they can eat only one complete meal and two smaller meals during the day, with no food in between. Catholics who are over the age of 14 are required to refrain from eating meat, or any food made with meat, on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays during Lent. PARISH LENTEN PENANCE SERVICE will take place on Wednesday, April 6th at 6:30 **p.m.** There will be a number of priests there that evening to hear individual confessions.
