
Mass Schedule



PARISH LENTEN PENANCE SERVICE will take place on Wednesday, April 6th at 6:30 p.m.

There will be a number of priests there that evening to hear individual confessions.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS will be on April 8th at 2:15 p.m. and 6:30 p.m.

LENTEN REGULATIONS Catholics who are over the age of 18 and under the age of 60 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, which means that they can eat only one complete meal and two smaller meals during the day, with no food in between. Catholics who are over the age of 14 are required to refrain from eating meat, or any food made with meat, on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays during Lent.



<u>CCD</u> 4-6 year olds and grades K & 1 meet on Sunday mornings during the 9:00 a.m. Mass. Grades 2 -8 meet on Wednesday evenings at 6:30 p.m. The first Wednesday of every month is Family Night and students in grades K-8 and their families are asked to attend at 6:30 p.m. in the church. Family Night is April 6th, which is the Parish Lenten Penance Service. All families are asked to attend to spiritually prepare for Easter.

encouraged to attend individual confession. All are most welcome to attend.


SPA DINNER CLUB REBOOT!



Another Great Week at SPAI


First grade tested their hands, feet, eyes and ears to see if they and their classmates were more right sided, left sided or mixed. Then the glass graphed their results.
