FAMILY PROMISE VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

St. Peter the Apostle will be hosting homeless families through the Family Promise program the weeks of July 17-23 and July 24-30. Although they no longer stay at the parish center, we still need to provide people to *spend the night* with them to help defray the costs of paying staff. The families stay at Oasis of Hope. We need spend the night people on the following nights: July 18, 19 & 20 and July 25, 26 & 27. Comfortable beds are provided and each family has a private room. If you and any members of your family would like to spend the night, please call or text Cathy Scanlon at 912-662-7173. This is a great way to help your children understand our Christian commitment to help those in need (and also a great way for students to get service hours!).

There is a basket in the narthex if you would like to *make a contribution* to the Family Promise program. Your help will go far in providing services, clothing, school uniforms, food, etc. for the homeless families in the Family Promise program.

Also, sign-up sheets are in the narthex for those who would like to *help provide meals* for the two weeks in July that St. Peter's is helping with this program.

YOUR "SCHOOL SUPPORT" DONATIONS

On the first weekend of each month a "School Support" envelope is included in your offering envelope package. Your donations to this fund are used to provide direct support to families in our school to assist them in paying tuition for their children. A small group of parishioners, along with Fr. Kavanaugh, examines the requests for assistance, without knowing the identity of those applying, and the awards are made based on need. If there are any remaining funds after the awards are made, this money is added to the school's savings. (We have recently spent \$77,000 from school savings to replace HVAC units in the upper school, so the money is well used). Along with this tuition support to families, the parish budget supports the school with \$176,000 per year in subsidy to the school budget. Our school is one of the most important ministries of our parish, and we are grateful for your generosity which makes this ministry possible. If you have any questions, please contact Fr. Kavanaugh.

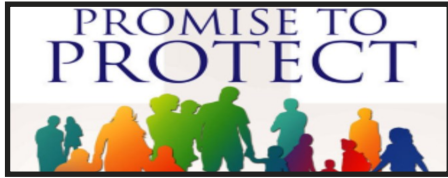
