

like to serve as an altar server. Anyone who has served in the past or who is currently in 4th grade and above are encouraged to join this important ministry.








Once again we are school supply collecting school supplies for children in need in our area.

GRACE Scholars is now accepting preregistrations for the 2023 education tax credits. You can pre-register at the GRACE website gracescholars.org and click on "For Donors" or you may request a paper form by emailing askgrace@gracescholars.org.

There are a few changes for 2023:

- Single/head of household tax credit limit lesser of tax liability or \$2,500. An increase from \$1,000.
- Married filing jointly tax credit limit lesser of tax liability or \$5,000. An increase from \$2.500.
- Pass through entity (S corp, partnership or LLC) tax credit limit lesser of tax liability or \$25,000. An increase from \$10,000.
- 2023 state tax credit cap increases to \$120 million up from \$100 million.

Your participation in this simple tax credit program through GRACE Scholars can help continue to make the dream of a Catholic school education possible for children with demonstrated financial need.

WORLD YOUTH DAY 2023

The next World Youth Day will be held in Lisbon, Portugal on August 1-6, 2023. The Diocese of Savannah is planning a 10-day pilgrimage spanning from July 28-August 7, 2023 to Fatima and Lisbon for this celebration of and for youth, as well as a pre-trip 4-day addon to Lourdes, Burgos and Santiago de Compostela, and a post-trip 2-day add-on to Avila, Madrid and Toledo. This is an unbelievable week-long spiritual journey where pilgrims from all over the world unite to share their faith. The week includes prayer, song, concerts, drama, sharing, liturgy, catechesis, and an unforgettable vigil and closing Mass with the Holy Father Francis.
