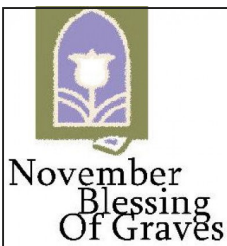

PARISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM 4 year olds thru K & 1st grade: please attend the 9:00 a.m. Mass as a family. Your child will leave before the readings with a teacher/helper and have a 20 minute lesson, then return to Mass for the final blessing. **2nd & 3rd grades** will meet on Wednesday evenings from 6:30 - 7:30 p.m. in the youth center. They will prepare and review the Sacraments as a team, but will also focus on the Gospel message for each week. **4th, 5th & 6th grades** will have the choice to meet one of two days. There will be a Wednesday afternoon class from 5:00 - 6:00 p.m. **AND** a Sunday morning class from 10:00 - 11:00 a.m., both held in the youth center. ***Please commit to the one that works for your schedule.*** **7th grade** is the Confirmation prep year. GRACE Scholars is now accepting pre-registrations for the 2023 education tax credits. You can pre-register at the GRACE website gracescholars.org and click on "For Donors" or you may request a paper form by emailing askgrace@gracescholars.org.

There are a few changes for 2023:

- Single/head of household tax credit limit - lesser of tax liability or \$2,500. An increase from \$1,000.
- Married filing jointly tax credit limit - lesser of tax liability or \$5,000. An increase from \$2,500.
- Pass through entity (S corp, partnership or LLC) tax credit limit - lesser of tax liability or \$25,000. An increase from \$10,000.
- 2023 state tax credit cap increases to \$120 million up from \$100 million.

Your participation in this simple tax credit program through GRACE Scholars can help continue to make the dream of a Catholic school education possible for children with demonstrated financial need. 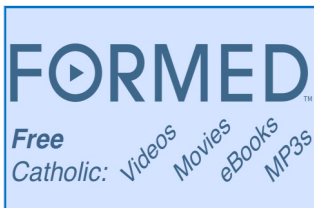

The next World Youth Day will be held in Lisbon, Portugal on August 1-6, 2023.
