### SECOND COLLECTION

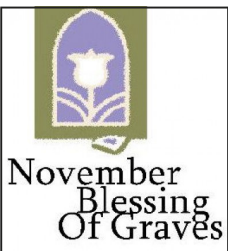
this weekend is for the *Archdiocese for the Military Services*. The ministries offered by the AMS benefit those who serve in all six branches of the U.S. Armed

GRACE Scholars is now accepting pre-registrations for the 2023 education tax credits. You can pre-register at the GRACE website [gracescholars.org](http://gracescholars.org) and click on "For Donors" or you may request a paper form by emailing [askgrace@gracescholars.org](mailto:askgrace@gracescholars.org).

There are a few changes for 2023:

- Single/head of household tax credit limit - lesser of tax liability or \$2,500. An increase from \$1,000.
- Married filing jointly tax credit limit - lesser of tax liability or \$5,000. An increase from \$2,500.
- Pass through entity (S corp, partnership or LLC) tax credit limit - lesser of tax liability or \$25,000. An increase from \$10,000.
- 2023 state tax credit cap increases to \$120 million up from \$100 million.
