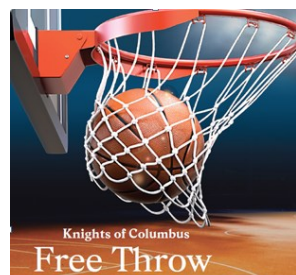

A "teaching Mass" is a Mass during which the priest catechizes about the various parts and aspects of the Mass.

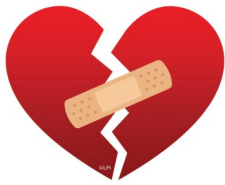

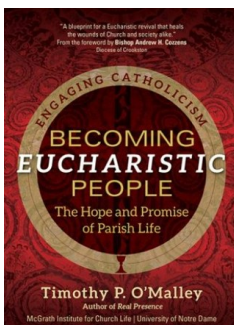

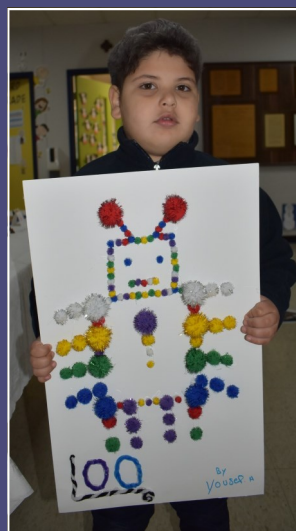
