



Any information including Mass intentions for these upcoming bulletins are due in to Clare Zeigler in the parish office by noon on the following dates: April 2nd: due Monday, March 27th April 9th: due Wednesday, March 29th



*April 4th - Chrism Mass* will be celebrated at the Cathedral Basilica of St. John the Baptist at 11:00 a.m. At this liturgy the Holy oils used in the celebration of the Sacraments are blessed by Bishop Parkes. All are invited to attend.

*April 6th - Holy Thursday Mass* will be celebrated at 7:00 p.m. to commemorate Our Lord's Last Supper, followed by Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament until 11:00 p.m. **There is NO** 7:30 a.m. Mass that morning.

*April 7th - Good Friday* There will be Stations of the Cross at 3:00 p.m. At 7:00 p.m. there will be a Liturgical Service, Veneration of the Cross and Holy Communion. The Pontifical Good Friday collection is for the Holy Land. **There is NO 7:30 a.m. Mass that morning.** *April 8th - Holy Saturday Anticipated Mass of the Resurrection* will be celebrated at 8:30 p.m. We will welcome our R.C.I.A. candidates into the Catholic faith at this Mass. All are welcome to attend. **Please note: there will be NO 5:30 p.m. Vigil Mass that evening.** *April 9th - Easter Sunday* Masses will be celebrated at the usual times: 7:30 a.m., 9:00 a.m., and 11:15 a.m. The Second Collection will be for the Priests' Retirement Fund.



**STATIONS OF THE CROSS** On the Fridays of Lent, we will have Stations of the Cross at 6:30 p.m. There will also be Stations of the Cross at 2:15 p.m. on March 31st.

**LENTEN REGULATIONS** Catholics who are over the age of 18 and under the age of 60 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, which means that they can eat only one complete meal and two smaller meals during the day, with no food in between. Catholics who are over the age of 14 are required to refrain from eating meat, or any food made with meat, on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays during Lent.

**<u>PARISH LENTEN PENANCE SERVICE</u>** will take place on *Wednesday, March 29th at 6:30 p.m.* There will be a number of priests there that evening to hear individual confessions.



**FIRST PENANCE** will be held on Wednesday, April 19th at 6:30 p.m. in the church. The children will offer confessions


