

**Confirmation Date: TBA** MANDATORY BOOT CAMP will be held on August 13th, 20th, 27th and September 17th from 5:00 - 7:00 p.m. Candidates and family are required to be registered and participating in a parish in the diocese. If you are not registered at St. Peter the Apostle, you are asked to bring a letter from the Pastor of the church you are registered in acknowledging your participation. The Diocese of Savannah requires ALL candidates seeking Confirmation to be enrolled concurrently in a religious education program during the year in which they prepare for the sacrament OR a Catholic school. Candidates are required to complete 20 hours of community service. Vacation Bible School, Family Promise, and the Altar Server ministry are great opportunities available over the summer.
