
## Mass Schedule




WOMEN'S BOOK STUDY will not meet again until January.

GRACE Scholars is now accepting preregistrations for the 2024 education tax credits. You can pre-register at the GRACE website gracescholars.org and click on "For Donors" or you may request a paper form by emailing askgrace@gracescholars.org. There were a few changes in 2023:

- Single/head of household tax credit limit lesser of tax liability or \$2,500. An increase from \$1,000.
- Married filing jointly tax credit limit lesser of tax liability or \$5,000. An increase from \$2,500.
- Pass through entity (S corp, partnership or LLC) tax credit limit lesser of tax liability or \$25,000. An increase from \$10,000.
- 2024 state tax credit cap is \$120 million. Your participation in this simple tax credit program through GRACE Scholars can help continue to make the dream of a Catholic school education possible for children with demonstrated financial need.




#### TO ALL CATHOLIC FAMILIES REQUESTING OR RECEIVING CATHOLIC TUIITON RATE AT ST. PETER THE APOSTLE SCHOOL

A family must be:

- Registered in the Parish
- Attend Mass on all Sundays and Holy Days
- Participate in the Sacraments of the Church
- Go to confession at least once a year
- Participate actively in parish events
- Contribute regularly to the parish offertory in a recognizable way, by parish envelope or check
