

Catholics who are over the age of 14 are required to refrain from eating meat, or any food made with meat, on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays during Lent. 

1. Ministerial Code of Conduct

2. Policy on the Sexual Abuse of Minors **Every active volunteer and employee** must read and acknowledge **both** documents. To complete this task:

- 1. Log into your account at virtus.org
- 2. Go to the box marked "Required Documents." If it is pink, you have documents to sign
- 3. Right-click both document titles (Ministerial Code of Conduct **and** Sex Abuse Policy) and for each one, select "open link in new tab."
- 4. Read each document, scroll down, and apply your electronic signature.
- 5. Return to your Home tab to see if any other outstanding compliance items are required. To see the most up-to-date information after signing the documents, you may need to refresh the page by clicking the circular arrow at the top, near the URL.
