

*March 26th - Chrism Mass* will be celebrated at the Cathedral Basilica of St. John the Baptist at 11:00 a.m. At this liturgy the Holy oils used in the celebration of the Sacraments are blessed by Bishop Parkes. All are invited to attend.

March 28th - Holy Thursday Mass will be celebrated at 7:00 p.m. to commemorate Our Lord's Last Supper, followed by Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament until 11:00 p.m.

There is NO 7:30 a.m. Mass that morning.

*March 29th - Good Friday* There will be Stations of the Cross at 3:00 p.m. At 7:00 p.m. there will be a Liturgical Service, Veneration of the Cross and Holy Communion. The Pontifical Good Friday collection is for the Holy Land. **There is NO 7:30 a.m. Mass that morning.** 

*March 30th - Holy Saturday Anticipated Mass of the Resurrection* will be celebrated at 8:30 p.m. We will welcome our R.C.I.A. candidates into the Catholic faith at this Mass. We pray for them as they continue on their faith journey. All are welcome to attend.

Please note: there will be NO 5:30 p.m. Vigil Mass that evening.

March 31st - Easter Sunday Masses will be celebrated at the usual times: 7:30 a.m., 9:00 a.m., and 11:15 a.m. The Second Collection will be for the **Priests' Retirement Fund**. This collection provides a very important contribution to the pension fund for our diocesan priests. When a diocesan priest retires, he must provide for himself primarily through the pension he receives from the Diocese of Savannah and Social Security Insurance. The number of priests retiring will increase in the next ten to fifteen years. Your contributions help our retired priests take care of themselves in their later years. We thank you for your generosity and gratitude for the service of the priests of the diocese.

*March 31st through April 7th - The Chaplet of Divine Mercy* will be recited every day at 3:00 p.m. We pray for mercy in our own lives and others too. We pray to remind ourselves that we must rely on God and recognize our weaknesses and replace our anxieties with abounding trust in God. We must live out the words "Jesus, I trust in You."



- 1. Ministerial Code of Conduct
- 2. Policy on the Sexual Abuse of Minors

Every active volunteer and employee must read and acknowledge both documents. To complete this task:

- 1. Log into your account at virtus.org
- 2. Go to the box marked "Required Documents." If it is pink, you have documents to sign
- 3. Right-click both document titles (Ministerial Code of Conduct and Sex Abuse Policy) and for each one, select "open link in new tab."
- 4. Read each document, scroll down, and apply your electronic signature.
- 5. Return to your Home tab to see if any other outstanding compliance items are required. To see the most up-to-date information after signing the documents, you may need to refresh the page by clicking the circular arrow at the top, near the URL.
